

MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT-February 2016

1. Sankalp Team in association with Empowered Kids Foundation started a full fledged tuition centre at MIG Colony , Near Durga Mandap , Adityapur, The centre has now started functioning with classes held regularly in three shifts on chiefly two aspects
 - a. Classes are held in 3 shifts at MIG Centre
 - i. 3.30 PM-4.30 PM-Priyanka Mam,Saraswati Devi-Junior Section
 - ii. 4.30 PM-5.30 PM-Rajan Sir & Dilip Sir-Secondary Section
 - iii. 5.30 PM-7 PM-Navodaya Team-Entrance Preparation
 - b. A team of dedicated volunteers from NIT , who are themselves Navodaya Alumnus are taking classes for selected children for admissions
 - c. Second Year Volunteers have also joined the team for taking classes at MIG Centre
2. Considering our draft proposal for sponsoring the complete admission fee for the academic session 2016-2017 of selected students from Sankalp's Telco Centre TML Drivelines handed over a cheque of Rs. 44000/- towards the educational expenditure for the coming year.
3. Sankalp in association with Brahmakumari- A nationwide renowned NGO for organizing health camps for underprivileged people children arranged a health camp at Mohan Nagar and NIT Centre. Complete dental and eye check up both for Sankalp children and their parents were done and medicines were distributed free of cost by the medical team of Brahamakumari.
4. Sankalp centres at Jami and Banka, the two most backward districts of Bihar have started functioning from 1st February. The focus here initially is to build the fundamentals by grouping children according to their level and teach them basics of every subject from the kindergarten level. A copy of Sanjeevani has been shared with the Centre coordinators to ensure a common pattern of and syllabi across all Sankalp Centres. 1st common test was also held on 20th Feb at the centre/
5. Sankalp plans to further collaborate with Pahal to expand it footprints in Bihar across 12 districts namely
 - a. Lakhisaray
 - b. Shekhapura
 - c. Nawada
 - d. Gaya
 - e. Bihar Sharif
 - f. Samastipur
 - g. Bhagalpur
 - h. Khagariya
 - i. Begusarai
6. Sanjeevani, Sankalp's first edition of comprehensive syllabus for all classes to benchmark educational levels at all our centres was released on 26th January. Copies of Sanjeevani have now been given to teachers at all centres. The syllabus has been formed by compiling the basic minimum syllabus of all boards and aspires to achieves for all students a basic minimum academic level]
7. Special classes for girls and their mothers enrolled at our centres were organized on 7th Feb at our Imli & Aashiyana Centres... The class was conducted by Girls Volunteers of Sankalp and the impact was overwhelming with many girls shared their ignorance on basic hygiene and personal health. This was again a milestone for Sankalp as physical education is literally not covered in any syllabi of GOI. The topics touched were:
 - a. Negative and positive touch
 - b. Understanding their body when they reach puberty

- c. Periods (since most of the girls in poor families use cloth and pads are not affordable, they should be taught how to properly use cloth like regular washing drying etc)
8. Test was conducted at NIT centre to group the children according to their actual academic levels. Grouping has successfully been done at NIT Centre and special classes are currently organized by volunteers on every Sunday. Volunteers have formed groups to pay special attention to weak children
9. Sankalp added to its list of sponsored children with 4 children admitted in GSN in Feb 16
 - a. Raj Jha, Class 1
 - b. Khageshwar Mahato, Class UKG
 - c. Samriti Patra. Class 1
 - d. Deepak Kumar , Class 1
10. 3 student s have been identified from Dhanbad Centre for admission to nearby private school in the session 2016-2017
 - a. Mantu Kumar
 - b. Arti Kumari Yadav
 - c. Chandan Kumar Yadav
 - d. Their admission related formalities will be handled by Dhanbad Team.
11. Rajneesh, our teacher at Aashiyana has started preparation for Navodaya Entrance from Feb'16 month. 10 qty oxford English and translation were procured and handed over to him.
 - a. Sponsorship Team has sent mails to all the probable sponsors
12. Outcomes of the meeting between Sankalp Team & Mahila Durbar:
 - a. Mahila Durbar welcomed & appreciated our efforts and eagerness to support children of sex workers in Sonagachhi
 - b. Mahila Team is ready to allow Sankalp to implement our academic model and Syllabus –Sanjeevani for learning improvements of such children
 - c. Sankalp Team plans to visit Mahila Darbar's Office and residential school again in the month of March.
13. Sankalp Team submitted its application for participation in the annual donation festival called Kolkata gives festival
14. Sankalp organized a health camp at its Mohan Nagar Centre on 21st Feb 2016
 - a. The camp was organized in association with Brahmakumari NGO , Adityapur
 - b. Brahmakumari had arranged for the visit of doctors of Government Hospitals whereas medicines distributed to needy children and parents were sponsored by Sankalp
 - c. Around 120 children and their parents particularly mothers were given
 - i. Free of cost check up
 - ii. Medicines were distributed as per prescription
 - iii. Critical health issues of every patient was noted
15. Moral Values Session was conducted at NIT Centre to inculcate these values and ethics in children thru
 - a. Moral Science Classes
 - b. Covering Spiritual side of Mythological stories
 - c. Habits pertaining cleanliness, hygiene and discipline
 - d. Human Values such as honesty, brotherhood, respectfulness
16. Sankalp President met Tata Steel CSR department officials and submitted the complete details of its requirements for existing expenditure and expansion plan. The meeting ended on a positive note and Tata Steel will consider the proposal as communicated by CSR Head.

17. Sankalp is now focussing on extending support to more of such needy children thru help received from our 92 batch Alumni- Kapil Modi. Efforts to be made in the following areas by president
 - a. Setting up a centre in the slum area near Dindli Enclave
 - b. Approaching Tata Steel for becoming its CSR arm in areas around CRM Bara
 - c. Approach 92 batch alumnus for fund rising
18. Sankalp organized a health camp at its Imla Chauk Centre on 28th Feb 2016
 - a. The camp was organized in association with Brahmakumari NGO , Adityapur
 - b. Brahmakumari had arranged for the visit of doctors of Government Hospitals whereas medicines distributed to needy children and parents were sponsored by Sankalp
 - c. Around 60 children and their parents particularly mothers were given
 - i. Free of cost check up
 - ii. Medicines were distributed as per prescription
 - iii. Critical health issues of every patient was noted
19. Long awaited wonder trip i.e. Tata Zoological Garden Visit for Mohan Nagar and NIT Centre kids were organized on 28th Feb. Students were enthralled to see live some of the wild animals which they had only seen in books.
20. Aaj Tak, India's foremost National Television Channel visited Sankalp's Centres at NIT and interviewed President and other volunteers. The reporter was very appreciative of our efforts and wanted to publicize the noble work that was done by Sankalp for tribal children thru live telecast of Aaj Tak Channel in the bulletin called Speed News.
21. 2nd Common Test was conducted at NIT and Mohan Nagar centres.
22. Mr Sanjay Singh, employed in Pellet Plant of Tata Steel organized a donation event at MIG centre with the help of his childhood friends. 80 regular students of our centres were distributed stationeries like registers, geometry box etc on 27th Feb
23. Many new sponsors expressed willingness in sponsoring a needy child. New sponsors found were

24. Sankalp received a cheque of Rs. 44,000/- from TML drivelines for sponsoring the educational expenditure of needy children identified near Telco Centre from the areas of Bantanagar and Ghodabandha.
25. Naam Foundation, an NGO operating in drought prone and drought hit areas of Marathwada and Aurangabad, approached Sankalp Team for sponsoring 10 children of farmers who have committed suicide in the last 1 year from academic session of 2016-2017. Mr. Raja Bhau from Naam Foundation will prepare the data and submit to Sankalp Team by June End.
26. A sponsor tracking sheet has been developed in XL form to monitor the fund flow from sponsors. Sponsorship team will send reminders to sponsors for monthly and timely deposit of amount for the intended child

27. Reminder was sent to alumnus of 87 and 92 batch who had expressed interest in sponsoring children and as a result, Mr. Madhur & Mr. Sunil Aggarwal agreed to sponsor 2 children from Imli Chauk Centre.
28. Monthly Financial Report will now be generated online thru the Admin Panel interface.
29. Pellet Plant JDC Team from Tata Steel organized a donation drive at MIG Centre for students enrolled at the centre. Pen, Copies, pencils and other stationery were distributed to around 80 children.
30. President also submitted a draft proposal for extending sankalp centre across the country to the CSR Dep't of ONGC.
31. Sankalp organized a PR cum awareness session in Rickshaw Basti and Bantanagar to address the issue of low attendance at MIG centre
32. Sanjeevani has been dispatched to our outstation centres –Jamui & Banka, Madhepura,
33. Common Test-1 has now been conducted at all Sankalp Centres and marks are captured in the master sheet to record their performance.
34. After organizing a mass donation drive at Madhepura Centre, Goonj is now collaborating with Sankalp to organize similar events for JSR based Centres.
35. Monthly interaction led by President took place with the Team and special mention was made to the tireless efforts which the volunteers are making for making the different activities successful
36. Both Sankalp-A pledge to change and Sankalp Volunteers group FB page noted huge hike in likes and membership over the month
37. Sankalp saw a huge rise in daily requests for addition to its FB Page of Sankalp Volunteers group
